



1. Eligibility.

For the 2018 – 2019 academic year, school group reservations from public and private K – 12 schools will be accepted for visits on ***Thursdays and Fridays only.***

2. Maximum Attendance.

We can accept reservations of ***no more than 60 individuals***, including students, chaperones, and teachers together. This is not intended to mean 60 students plus additional adults, but rather to be capped at 60 people total per group reservation. Schools wishing to bring larger groups must divide into smaller groups of no more than 60 visitors that come on separate days.

3. Advance Reservations Required: tours@niagarafallsundergroundrailroad.org

Reservations must be ***confirmed via email*** by the Heritage Center group tour coordinator a ***minimum of 14 calendar days*** (2 weeks) before the anticipated visit.

4. Rates.

Admission rates when reservation confirmed 2 weeks in advance:

- a. K – 12 students: \$4
- b. Chaperones: \$4
- c. K – 12 teachers: free
- d. Tour guide/bus driver: free

5. Late Arrivals.

Admission to the museum occurs on a timed-entry basis in groups of approximately 20 individuals, every 15 minutes. Therefore, your timely arrival is extremely important, as the next available time slot may be sold out.

Please be aware that we will make every effort to accommodate late arrivals, but **groups arriving late may need to wait up to 60 minutes or more** for the next open admission time slot and **are not guaranteed a guided tour.**

6. College groups, homeschool groups, and student camp groups are ineligible for the K – 12 student rate and are governed by the Community Group Tour Policies.
